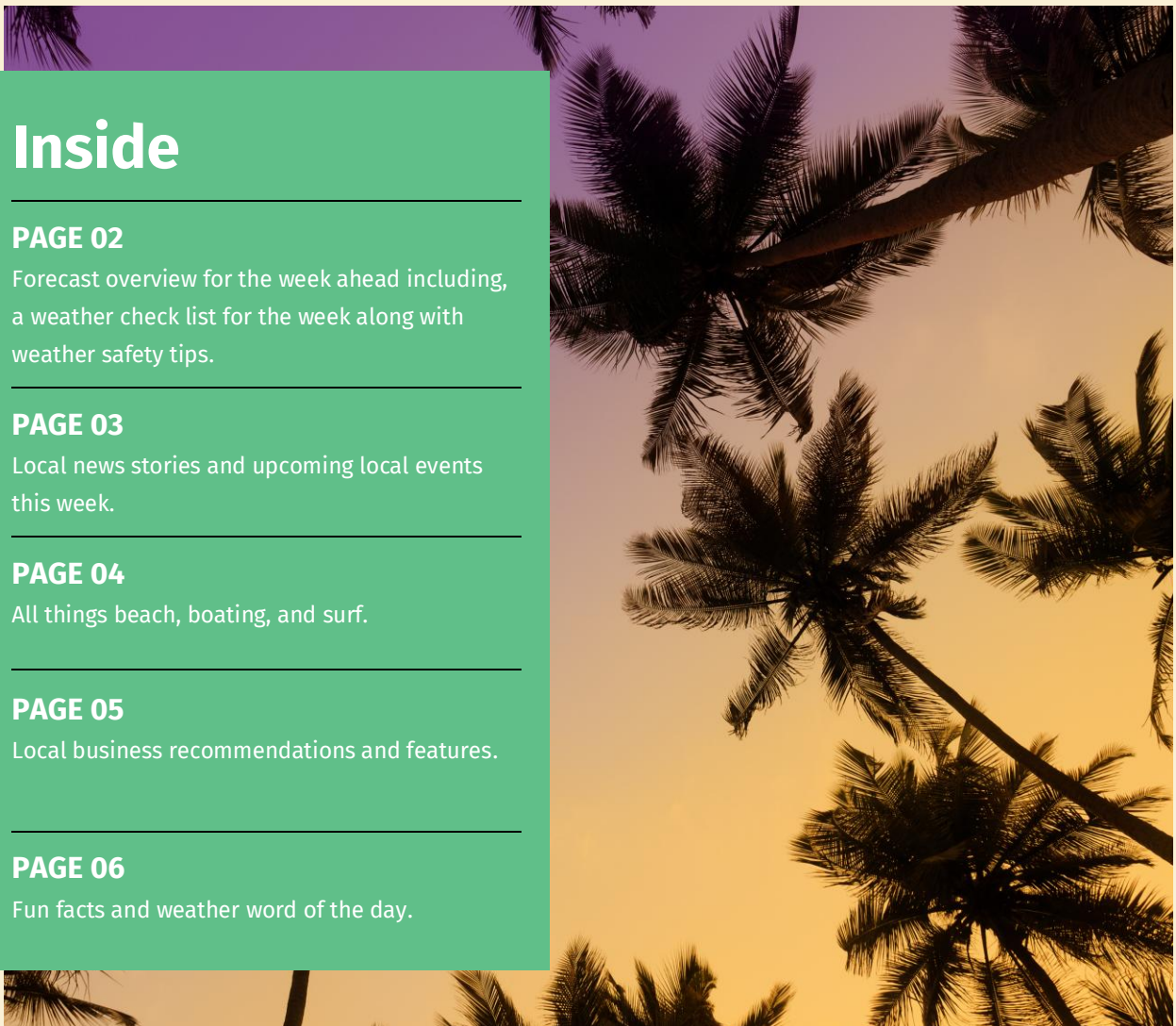

This Week's Weather Overview

As we head into the final days of July and turn the calendar to August, we are staying locked into our classic Southwest Florida summer weather pattern. Expect hot, humid conditions all week long, with afternoon high temperatures consistently hovering in the upper 80s°F range and feeling around the 100°F range. Mornings may feature a few isolated showers and storms along with some afternoons with breaks in-between. Thick humidity sticks around, but that's nothing new for this time of year! Overnight lows will remain very muggy in the upper 70s°F range nearing 80°F. Keep that umbrella close! For detailed daily forecasts, check my Facebook page & website.

Quick Weather Checklist for the Week:

- ✓ **✓ Dress for:** Peak summer heat in the low 90s°F. Lightweight, breathable clothing and sunglasses are essential, and an umbrella is mandatory.
- ✓ **✓ Outdoor plans:** Schedule your exercise, errands, and yard work during the breaks in between any rain/storms.
- ✓ **✓ Driving:** Expect slower afternoon commutes. Heavy downpours will cause sudden drops in visibility and slick local roads.
- ✓ **✓ Pets/plants:** Mother Nature will handle most of the lawn watering this week, but always check pavement temperatures before morning dog walks!
- ✓ **✓ Energy saving:** With overnight lows stuck in the upper 70s°F and surging humidity, your AC will definitely be working around the clock.



Weather Safety

Safety Tip of The Week: With daily afternoon downpours leaving standing water around yards, mosquito activity surges in late summer. Empty out flower pots, buckets, and birdbaths at least once a week to eliminate breeding grounds and apply EPA-registered insect repellent when outdoors during dawn and dusk.

Hurricane Preparedness Tip of the Week: Stock up on portable power banks and keep them fully charged! If a storm knocks out the power grid, you will need backup battery power to charge your devices, receive emergency weather alerts, and stay connected with family.

Boating & Beach Report

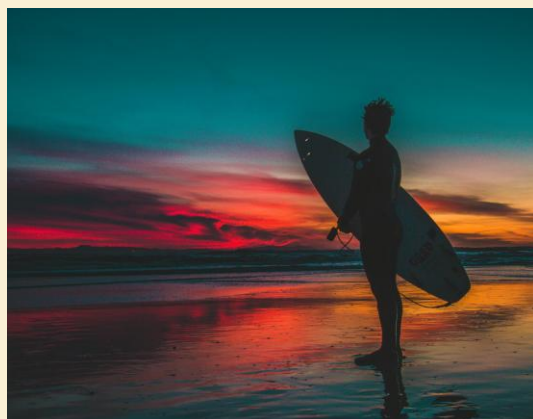
Best Beach Day: A typical Florida summer week is ahead which means you will be dodging rain drops and potentially lightning strikes at the beaches every day (When thunder roars, go indoors)! Keep an eye on the sky if you are planning beach days this week!

Best Boating Day: Most of this week looks choppy to rough at times with 2-3 footers during the early portion of the week offshore. By the weekend offshore seas could build to the 3-4-foot range at times. Nearshore boating/fishing will be your best bet for normal conditions! Additionally, we could see winds gusting 20-25 mph at times throughout the week!

Surf Report

Best Surf Day: This week will feature great surfing days pretty much all week long with seas ranging from 2 to 4 feet at times and onshore winds!

Weather Word of The Week

This week's word is **Microburst**

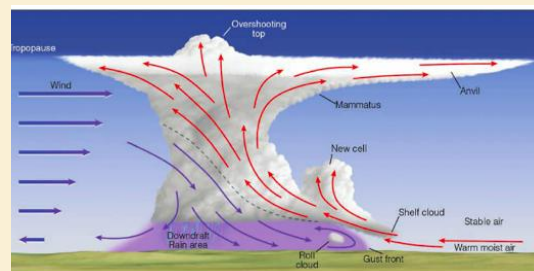
A localized, intense column of sinking air (downdraft) within a thunderstorm that rushes down to the ground and spreads out violently in all directions.

Example: When an afternoon thunderstorm collapses, it can release a sudden microburst that creates powerful, straight-line wind gusts capable of knocking over patio furniture, snapping tree branches, and turning calm Gulf waters choppy in seconds!

Did you know?

Florida's summer storms act like natural air conditioning!

Florida's summer afternoon thunderstorms act as Mother Nature's natural air conditioning! When heavy rain falls from a thunderstorm, it drags cool air down from the upper atmosphere with it, often dropping surface temperatures by 10 to 15 degrees in less than twenty minutes!
